

## Car Park Rules

- ◆ No stopping or parking on yellow lines.
- ◆ No parking in yellow box, marked with diagonal lines.

## The School

We will provide:

- ◆ a safe, well ordered, caring environment which encourages and enables children to learn,
- ◆ appropriate teaching and learning activities to encourage children to do their best at all times and achieve their potential,
- ◆ early home/school contact to sort out difficulties linked to your child's work, relationships or behaviour,
- ◆ helpful and clear information about what your child will be taught and how they are progressing,
- ◆ Safe access to the learning platform and computers ensuring internet safety and respecting the need for information,
- ◆ information about school activities through regular letters home,
- ◆ continuity of behaviour management to promote positive attitudes and caring of the community, (including an anti-bullying policy),
- ◆ Homework activities to consolidate and extend learning.

## The Family

We will:

- ◆ support our child in their school work and opportunities for home learning,
- ◆ Support our child with homework that is completed by the child,
- ◆ ensure our child arrives at school between 8.45 and by 8.55 am at the latest, prepared for the day's activities with the correct equipment and wearing the correct school uniform,
- ◆ make certain our child attends regularly and inform the school by 9.30 am on the first day of the reason for our child's absence,
- ◆ attend Parent/Teacher consultations and maintain contact with the school throughout our child's time at Grovelands,
- ◆ ensure that our child adheres to the internet safety policy of the school (available from the School Office),
- ◆ make sure our child is aware of and adheres to the school rules (see over),
- ◆ contribute to the all children's and adults safety by following the school car park rules (see over).

## School Uniform

White polo shirt (KS1 only),  
White shirt (KS2)  
Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore dress  
Navy blue V neck jumper or cardigan (with school logo or plain)  
School tie (KS2, optional KS1)  
Plain grey or black socks (boys)  
Plain white socks, or grey or white tights (girls)  
Shoes, plain black school shoes (girls, heels no higher than 2.5 cm)

*Boots may be worn to school in winter but children must change into school shoes or plimsolls in the school building.*

**Summer option**—Boys may wear grey shorts without a logo

Girls may wear a blue gingham dress or as for winter with short sleeved shirt

Hats for sun protection

**Summer PE**—white T-shirt (not polo), plain or with school logo, blue shorts, plimsolls

Winter PE—Plain navy blue hooded sweatshirt or school round neck sweatshirt and jogging trousers, plimsolls (Years 1—6)

Sports trainers for outdoor PE (KS2)
